Gioacchino Alvente was born in Barletta, Italy in 1963. He graduated in architecture from the Politecnico of Turin in 1986. He was Assistant Lecturer for Interior Design at the Politecnico of Turin from 1988 to 1992.

In 1986 he collaborate with "Gabetti and Isola architects" at the XVII Triennale of Milan.

From 1984 to 1990 he works as project leader in an important Turin architects firm, "Studio Rolla".

In 1991 he sets up his own firm in Turin, "Studio Alvente", working on local projects but also starting collaborations with architects' firms in Dusseldorf, Germany.

In 1995 he founds, in association with architects Alberto Priolo, Dieter Lorengel and Sabine Altrogge, the I.A.W. -Internationale Architektur Werkstatt- with offices in Dresden, Dusseldorf and Turin.

In 1998 he reopens his own studio in Turin, maintaining collaborations with other architects in Italy and Germany.

Gioacchino Alvente participates in important competitions obtaining prestigious invitational results, including: in 1990 the second prize for the design of two skyscrapers in Frankfurt; in 1994 the first prize for the head office of Dresdner Bank in Dresden ended in December 1997; in 1995 the first prize for the construction of the Hilton Hotel in Frankfurt, unveiled in December 1998; in 2001 finalist and third place for the new station of Porta Susa, Turin; in 2002 the city stadium and Hockey stadium for the 2006 Turin Olympics; in 2007 second prize for the project of a new hangar of Cannes-Mandelieu airport in France.

From 2007 to 2010 he works on private villas in France and great projects of real estate developments in Russia.

In 2010 "Studio Alvente" join "Frlan+Jansen Architetti" for the "Lavazza Selection", a competition for Lavazza's new headquarter in Turin, in collaboration with "Ove Arup Ltd." London.

Since 2011, in association with the International Architecture Workshop (IAW) based in Turin, Dusseldorf and Moscow, he mainly focus his works on private projects in Italy, France, Austria, Germany, Russia, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan and United States of America.
